

Better Information Management = Better Incident Management

The WA-COP Dashboard Stream provides a real-time and historical view of events and activities in the region. Additionally, quick links to each of the other WA-COP solutions, resources and information are available at the top of the screen.

Access the Dashboard:

1. Go to <http://wa-cop.org>
2. Browse to the "WA-COP Login Links" page
3. Click the button for CommandBridge
4. Log in to CommandBridge
5. Select "WA-COP Dashboard" at the top of the screen.
6. Select either "Stream" or "Panels"

STREAMS – This is a real-time feed of significant movements of vessels. Automatically updating, this feed can stay up all the time for continual viewing.

PANELS – Switch to WA-COP Dashboard Panels to see events and situations and follow their progress.

QUICK LINKS – Use these links to log into any of the other WA-COP solutions you may have access to.

EVENT – Notifications of vessels under way are displayed in chronological order.

REPLAY - See where the vessel actually was based upon AIS data. Clicking here will display the vessel at that location on the map.

VESSEL INFO – Clicking on the name of the vessel will display additional information about the vessel, if available.

MAP – Basic map functionality removes clutter and gets to the information you are looking for, quicker.

Better Information Management = Better Incident Management

The WA-COP Panels provide a brief descriptions of events, activities, or incidents. Users can add or update short pieces of information. Users can create customized personal dashboards, share status information, or track the progress of an event. This is especially important if you are trying to spread pertinent information regarding an incident which may affect other Puget Sound Maritime partners. Accessing the Dashboard:

1. Go to <http://wa-mcop.org>
2. Browse to the "WA-COP Login Links" page
3. Click the button for CommandBridge
4. Log in to CommandBridge
5. Select "WA-COP Dashboard" at the top of the screen.
6. Select either "Stream" or "Panels"

STREAMS – Switch to Dashboard Streams where you can see a real-time feed of significant movements of vessels. Automatically updating, this feed can stay up all the time for continual viewing.

PANELS – Displaying and sharing only the information you are interested in.

QUICK LINKS – Use these links to log into any of the other WA-COP solutions you have access to.

Panels – Create new panels to be shared amongst users. Automatically sorted by your organization or ones you've created. Each panel can be set to be color coded, percentage or a list of items.

Groups – Groups can be created for an organization or particular event/incident. This helps organize your notifications.
